We have buried 21 people, commending them to God. Bill and I have blessed the marriages of two couples, though at other venues. But my greatest joy has been our weekly celebrations of the Holy Eucharist. Thank you for that privilege.

Saying goodbye is never easy. It helps, however, to know that goodbye is short for "God be with you." And that is my prayer for you. Remember always that God is with you and that you *are* the Body of Christ. And every time you receive the bread that is Christ's body, *be what you see, receive what you are.*


Dear Lori and Sisters and Brothers in Christ,


